Students who achieved top three ranks in their respective classes were called up to receive certificates accompanied by their parents.



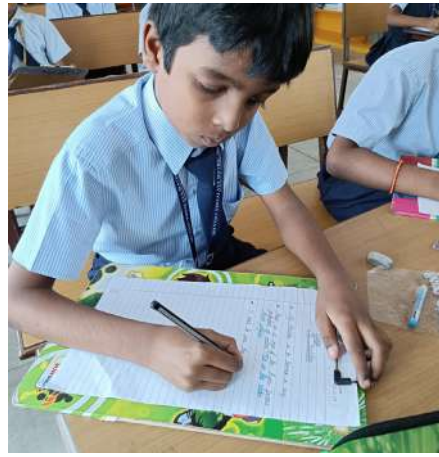
